JOB SUMMARY

The Director of Children's Ministry works with volunteers, parents, and other staff to ensure a stimulating, caring, nurturing environment where the children of the church are educated about God, scripture, and community through engaging Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, and additional age-appropriate events. Our Open and Affirming statement affirms that we love our neighbor as we love ourselves, and our neighbors include all races, ethnicities, physical and mental abilities, family configurations, sexual orientations, gender identities, and economic conditions.

1. Evaluate and select age and content appropriate curriculum for children's Sunday school classes all year (3 years – 5th grade).
2. Recruit Sunday School teachers and provide curriculum needs for classes.
3. Share the weekly message with the children during the service.
4. Plan regular activities and programs for the spiritual and social development of children in cooperation with the Christian Education committee. This would include, but not be limited to, service projects and mission projects.
5. Organize and direct Vacation Bible School.
6. Work with the Christian Education committee to provide nursery staff and volunteers for Sunday mornings.

The Director of Children's Ministry possesses a deep faith in Jesus Christ and has a heart and vision for the spiritual growth and nurture of children. The person has significant experience in working with children, working knowledge of the bible, and is familiar with the emotional and developmental needs of children. He/she is a self-starter and self-motivator and able to work with minimal supervision.
