GRANT FUNDING APPLICATION, CONT.

If funding is granted:

- 1. When will the project begin?
- 2. What is your estimated completion date?
- 3. Will you be willing to make a presentation to the local churches, clusters, associations (where applicable)?
- 4. Will you be willing to write a one-two page essay at the completion of your project for the Justice/Witness Ministry to describe:
 - Your beginning, middle and ending experiences throughout the process
 - The successes of your project
 - Any planning or implementation failures
 - Whether the social injustice was completely resolved
 - Your suggested solutions if this injustice continues
 - Your personal comments?
