WHAT:

In the Illinois Conference we are starting a "Fill the Bus" initiative to get youth signed up to attend the UCC National Youth Event in July 2016. The hope is to encourage youth to attend NYE and to help stretch out some of the costs (mostly transportation) amongst the churches and participants involved. It will help connect the youth within our conference and hopefully spark continued connections between churches and youth.

National Youth Event is an incredible event that only happens once every four years. Many of the youth in our churches right now will only have this chance once in their lifetime. It is a great way to connect our youth to the wider church and help them see how many more youth there are out there who are also a part of our denomination.

WHO:

Any church that wants to be a part of the joint trip to NYE would be welcome so long as they provide their own chaperones and can get themselves to the place of departure (TBD). Each church must submit the required paper work for their church and each participant along with a NON-REFUNDABLE \$50 deposit per person to reserve a space on the bus.

WHEN:

Our departure date is currently set for Monday, July 25, 2016 with arrival in Disney on July 26. We will be travelling straight through. NYE is from July 26-30. One of these days is a day in the parks, but we have a pass for a second day which we will stay and use on July 31, departing that evening to head back to Illinois. We will arrive in Illinois on Monday, August 1.

COST:

The total cost of the trip is estimated at the time. Official registration has not opened yet and there are still details we are awaiting from the National UCC. The cost breakdown is as follows and is our best guess based on the information we have so far. This does not include any money for souvenirs. Please see the Overview and Information section to see what is included with the registration cost.

Per Person Bus Cost \$250
Extra night in hotel (per person) \$75
Meals (not included in registration) \$100-150
Total Estimated Cost Per Person: \$1000
